



Swire Bulk 39,200 DWT Handysize Eco Bulk Carrier

Optimised cargo handling and fuel efficiency

The China Navigation Company (CNCo), the deep sea ship owning and operating arm of the multi-national Swire group, will be taking delivery of the first of its fully fitted log variant of the innovative, industry leading BDelta39 vessels in mid 2014. Twenty of these vessels are currently on order at Chinese shipyards. All twenty vessels will join CNCo's four non-logger BDelta39s trading on a worldwide basis.

The BDelta39 design will ensure that the vessels meet the highest environmental standards to achieve the lowest fuel consumption per ton-mile.

The attributes of the BDelta39 vessels include:

Main Engine Fuel Efficiency - Computer optimised hull lines, main engine and propeller specially designed to achieve the lowest fuel consumption with maximum efficiency at 70% MCR.

Cargo Handling Efficiency - The four 36t cargo cranes are variable speed MacGregor electric type which use approximately 40-50% less power than similar electrohydraulic cranes and have approximately 30% faster cycle time.

Reduced Auxiliary Power - Considerable effort has been made to reduce power consumption in all areas of the ship:

- The heat from the exhaust gases of the main engine and two of its three generators is used to make steam to heat the fuel. The speed of the main sea water pumps and engine room fans are automatically adjusted to suit the main engine power and regenerative heat is used to reduce heating for the purifiers;
- Electric winches and windlasses, low powered energy efficient lighting throughout the vessel and advanced navigational systems and a vessel energy management system to enhance navigational safety and minimise fuel consumption;
- Forced draft fans are installed in all holds to improve cargo care and facilitate the carriage of dangerous cargoes in bulk.

Fit for the future - The vessels exceed all current environmental regulations and are equipped with a ballast water treatment system, advanced incinerator and oily water separator plants.
